- Age 65+ receive high dose or adjuvanted vaccine

Your Preventative Health Reminders

Vaccines:

- Have you gotten your **COVID Vaccine**?
- 2-dose Shingles vaccines due for ages
 50+ & 2nd dose is 2-6 months later

Received a vaccine elsewhere?

Update your record by sending a copy to your Primary Care team and/or use the Annie App.

Screenings: Check before symptoms!

- Colon cancer screening starts at age 45
- Blood pressure screenings every year
- Breast cancer screening for women every year ages 40-74
- Cervical cancer screening every 3 years ages 21-29 and ages 30-65 every 3-5 years

Classes: Ask your Primary Care Team for details

- MOVE! Program: Supports weight loss goals with VVC classes over 16 weeks.
- **Diabetes Basics:** 7-week class on Fridays to support Veterans with pre-diabetes and diabetes at the main campus. Call 208-422-1000 x 7055 to schedule.
- **Healthy Teaching Kitchen (HTK):** 2–3-week classes offered in person on Wednesdays from 1PM to 2:30PM. Call 208-422-1000 x 7055 to schedule.
- <u>Taking Charge of My Life and Health:</u> 6 to 8 week in-person classes to explore what matters most in your life towards positive changes, learn healthy coping skills, and connect with valuable community resources. Call 208-422-1050 for more info.
